# Course Overview

Students taking GCSE French and Spanish will be taught:

3 Themes throughout the course:

- Identity and Culture
- Local, national, international and global areas of interest
- Current and future study and employment

These topics will be studied through the four skills; reading, listening, speaking and writing



# Assessment

They will be entered for either the Foundation or Higher Tier

Pupils will have 4 exams at the end of their course.

Each exam is worth 25%:

- Paper 1-Listening
- Paper 2- Speaking
- Paper 3-Reading & Translation
- Paper 4-Writing & Translation



# Additional information

- All students in Year 9 will be awarded an AQA FCSE Certificate in MFL. This is a certificate which is awarded by the AQA exam board. It is to recognise their achievements at the KS3. GCSE builds upon the knowledge and skills that they have been taught whilst studying for this certificate.
- The MFL Department organises yearly trips to either France or Spain. These trips enable pupils at KS4 & KS3 to attend language lessons & gain further insight into the culture that they're studying.
- All Pupils will be expected to interact with other pupils in the class in order to practise and embed their language skills. We have a very interactive approach in MFL and use a range of activities to enable the pupils to speak in French & Spanish.
- Pupils will be expected to use online platforms confidently in order to access & submit work and experience the language & culture of their chosen language.
