## Course Overview

This course gives learners the opportunity to develop sector-specific knowledge and skills in a practical learning environment. The focus is on four areas of equal importance, which cover the:

- development of key skills that prove your aptitude in Performing Arts such as reproducing repertoire or responding to stimuli
- process that underpins effective ways of working in the Performing Arts, such as development of ideas, rehearsal and performance
- attitudes that are considered most important in the Performing Arts, including personal management and communication
- knowledge that underpins effective use of skills, process and attitudes in the sector such as roles, responsibilities, performance disciplines and styles

## Assessment

### **Component 1 – Exploring the Performing Arts (Coursework 30% of Grade)**

Learners will develop their understanding of the performing arts by examining the work of performing arts professionals and the processes used to create performance.

### **Component 2 – Developing Skills and Techniques in the Performing Arts (Coursework 30% of Grade)**

Learners will develop their performing arts skills and techniques through the reproduction of dance and/or musical theatre repertoire as performers or designers.

### **Component 3 – Responding to a Brief (Exam 40% of Grade)**

Learners will be given the opportunity to work as part of a group to contribute to workshop performance as either a performer or a designer in response to a brief and stimulus.

## Additional Information

Performing Arts can benefit students who wish to pursue a career in the arts, media, the communications industry, marketing and any career that deals with the public or presentations in business.

Throughout the course, you will explore and develop a wide range of skills required for successful dance performance. In addition, you will develop your knowledge and understanding of different dances styles and genres through studying professional dance repertory.

The qualification can be used as a stepping-stone to a Level 3 in Performing Arts or Dance qualification or further performance education.
