## Course Overview

In GCSE German students will study 3 Themes throughout the course:

- Identity and Culture.
- Local, national, international and global areas of interest.
- Current and future study and employment.

These topics will be taught through the four skills: reading, listening, speaking and writing

## Assessment

Students will be entered for either the Foundation Tier (grades 1-5) or the Higher Tier (grades 4-9)

All exams are taken at the end of the course and consist of four papers. Each paper is worth 25%:

- Paper 1-Listening
- Paper 2- Speaking
- Paper 3-Reading & Translation
- Paper 4-Writing & Translation

## Additional Information

For those pupils who will be studying French or Spanish at GCSE, the study of German as a second language is being offered as an option at KS4.

The course content is delivered through a two- year scheme of work and would suit pupils with a passion and flair for modern languages.

All students will be expected to interact with other pupils in the class in order to practise and embed their language skills. We have a very interactive approach in MFL and will use a range of activities to enable the pupils to speak German

Students will be expected to use online platforms confidently in order to access & submit work and experience the language & culture of their chosen language.
